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This past year has been one of growth and resilience. Notable accomplishments include:

- Launch of the Reach Out and Read program, promoting literacy during well-child visits to enhance early childhood development.
- Appointment of our first community health worker who plays a vital role in reducing health disparities and helping patients access essential resources.
- Welcoming over 200 new patients to our dental practice, stepping in to fill the gap left by other offices who stopped accepting Medicaid.
- Purchase of property in Bennington for future growth of our primary care services, ensuring we can better meet the needs of Bennington County.

Quality Care: Our dedicated team delivered care during 16,746 patient visits. The quality of care provided during those visits earned BVHC the status of Gold Leader from the Health Resources and Services
 Administration, placing us in the top 10% of health centers nationally.

Increased Access to Food: We expanded our on-site food shelf, Hannah's Pantry, adding refrigerators and freezers. As a result, the number of fresh and frozen meals provided through Grateful Hearts rose from 20 to 60 weekly. Additionally, through our partnership with the Vermont Foodbank's Veggie Van Go program,
 f. we distributed 1,672 bags of fresh produce to



Community Outreach & Education Program: To address the dental care crisis, we empowered community members to take control of their oral health by distributing 3,956 toothbrushes, 3,099 tubes of toothpaste, and miles of floss along with educational materials. We also partnered with the Vermont Veterans Outreach Program and the Northeast Delta Dental Foundation to provide dental care to uninsured Vermont Veterans.
